

Masai Mara Safari

Masai Mara National Reserve is Kenya's finest wildlife reserve. The wildlife is abundant and the gentle rolling grasslands ensure that animals are never out of sight. Birds, too, are prolific. The Masai Mara is regarded as the jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing areas. The annual wildebeest's migration alone involves over 1.5 million animals arriving in July and departing in November.

There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians and reptiles and over 400 birds species recorded on the reserve. Nowhere in Africa is wildlife more abundant, and it is for this reason a visitor hardly misses to see the big five (buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhino). Other game includes hippos, cheetah, Grant's gazelle, impala, topi, Coke's hartebeest, giraffe, Roan antelope and the nocturnal bat-eared fox.

Masai Mara Tour

<u>Day 1: Nairobi</u> – Maasai Mara Game Reserve

Upon arrival aboard your morning flight from Mombasa. You will be met at the Airport by your Safari driver Guide at around 10.00am to begin your tour as you drive through the dramatic Great Rift Valley with a stopover at the view point to see the escarpment and another one in Narok town for lunch. After lunch, proceed further to Masaai Mara for an introductory evening game drive. Maasai Mara Game Reserve is an extension of vast Serengeti plains famously known for its spectacular great Wildebeest's migration and is home of the Big Five: Lion, Elephant, Leopard, Buffalo and Rhino. It is one of the greatest wildernesses of the world. Large mammals are varied, and easy to see. Residents among the Park's are: Maasai Giraffes, Buffaloes, Elands and thousands of plain game including Impalas, Zebras, Topis, both Thompson's and Grants Gazelles.

Day 2: Discover Maasai Mara Game Reserve

This day will be spent in the Mara with a full day game drive. This extensive game drive will take you to the rolling savannah grassland. On the plains are enormous herds of grazing animals plus the elusive Cheetah and Leopards hiding amidst Acacia boughs. In the evening you will have an opportunity to visit a village of the Maasai people to witness the singing and dancing that are part of their daily lives and sacred rituals. A glimpse into their homes and social structure is a poignant experience.

During our stay you may also enjoy an optional early morning Hot Air Balloon ride at an extra cost of US\$ 450 pp.

Day 3: Maasai Mara Game Reserve – Nairobi

Early morning tea / coffee or Hot chocolate, then depart for a morning game drive. After a full English breakfast back at the camp depart by road with hot lunch en-route in Narok town to arrive Nairobi in the evening to end your Adventure with a drop off at the airport for your onward flight to Mombasa.
